Minutes of the 7th Meeting of The International Academy of Mathematical Chemistry (IAMC-2011), held in Hotel Kompas, Bled, Slovenia, June 19-22, 2011.

SUNDAY Evening, 19th JUNE

IAMC Members gathered informally in Hotel Lovec (Bled), and enjoyed conversations, and spirits kindly offered by Tomaz Pisanski.

MONDAY, 20th JUNE

Morning Session 11:15-12:45

Roberto Todeschini (President) greeted the audience and gave some information about the worldwide visibility of the Academy.

In Wikipedia, the entry "International Academy of mathematical Chemitry" was recently introduces and there are two cross-links in he entries "Mathematical chemistry" and "Molecular descriptors".

The IAMC website http://www.iamc-online.org/index.htm has been accessed by 1823 visitors in the last year (1608 visitors in the previous year; +13%). The related website on the molecular descriptors http://www.moleculardescriptors.eu/ has been accessed by 7595 visitors in the last year (7022 in the previous year).

The tutorial section of the Molecular descriptors website was successful in the last few years:

Following this approach, Todeschini invited Academicians to send tutorials (of a few pages) on their preferred topics to open an analogous section in the IAMC website. The tutorials should be sent directly the IAMC President.

The next IAMC 2012 will be held in Verona, Italy, from June 13th to 16th, 2012, following the MCC meeting in Dubrovnik from June 4th to 9th, 2012 (see: http://mcc.irb.hr). The IAMC 2012 will be organized by Todeschini group jointly to the 2nd Summer Project School within the framework of Marie-Curie EU Project "Environmental Chemoinformatics" (June 10th to 15th, 2012. PhD students from EU- and not-EU Countries will attend to the IAMC lectures. For this reason, it has been proposed that some IAMC lecture should be more didactical-oriented.

All present voted in favour of these proposals.

Milan Randić warned that financial difficulties lay ahead for the IAMC and promised to send again circular letters to various National Academies appealing for them to make annual contributions to the IAMC of 100 Euros, preferably on a permanent basis.

Alexandru Balaban warned that the IAMC web page is vulnerable to attack by people of malign intent.

A proposal that the members of Governing Body could keep their posts for a period longer than six years was passed. Edward Kirby will inform Roger Mallion of this change and both will agree a revised wording of the relevant statute to take account of it.

Tomaž Pisanski resigned from the position of Vicepresident. Ante Graovac suggested Nikolai Zefirov for this post, but as he had not asked Zefirov for his agreement, the matter was postponed until the next Academy meeting. Sandi Klavžar and Edward Kirby were proposed as new Vicepresidents, and in such a way the IAMC intends to keep a balance between mathematicians and chemists. The Academicians present expressed their gratitude to Professor Pisanski for organizing the IAMC 2011 meeting and the Meeting of the Governing Body in Bled in 2009, and for all the many good things he has done for the IAMC during his term in office.
